ERUV TAVSHILIN

As Yom Tov falls on a Thursday and Friday

it is necessary to prepare an **Eruv** in order to be able to cook on Friday for Shabbat. This

is done by taking a **roll or piece of bread** and **something**

**cooked** (an egg, fish or meat) and putting them aside for the Shabbat meals.

One should recite the formula in the Siddur (p642)

or the Machzor

when doing so.

This needs to be done on the eve of:

**Rosh Hashanah, Succot and Shemini Atzeret**
